SUBJECT: MARITIME LABOUR CONVENTION, 2006, AS AMENDED. REPORT

OF OCCUPATIONAL ACCIDENTS, INJURIES AND DESEASES.

## Dear All:

By this means we would like to draw your attention to the contents of circular **MMC-274** regarding the reporting of occupational accidents, injuries and diseases that may happen onboard according to the standards established by the Maritime Labour Convention, 2006, as amended.

Reports are to be sent to the General Directorate of Merchant Marine Technical Department of Analysis and Maritime Certification, MLC Section via the following e-mail  $\underline{mlc@segumar.com}$ . The point of it is to ensure that:

- Occupational accidents, injuries and diseases are properly reported considering guidance from the International Labour Organization.
- Statistics of accidents, injuries and diseases are kept, analyzed and published followed up by investigation and research into trends and identified hazards.

In the case of natural death, suicide, homicide, sexual assault or any other serious marine casualty on board Panamanian flag vessels, they must be reported to the Maritime Affairs Investigation Department <a href="mailto:casualty@amp.gob.pa">casualty@amp.gob.pa</a> ensuring that the investigation related to the incident is performed only by personnel of the Maritime Affairs Investigation Department.
